Duties and Responsibilities

1. Adhere to the established *Policies and Procedures for TCCTA Committees (General—All Committees)*.
2. Promote the professional growth of Association members in all areas of development and performance.
3. Maintain awareness of all developments on the national, state, and local levels which would affect the professional status of members of the profession.
4. Prepare and submit to the Executive Committee, in cooperation with other committees of the Association, recommendations and/or resolutions promoting the adoption of meaningful policies on academic freedom and responsibility, tenure, and due process by all community, junior, and technical colleges in the state.
5. Seek means of elevating the status of community, junior, and technical college educators in every practical way and make appropriate recommendations to the Executive Committee.
6. Conduct research on issues as required by the Association or by the Executive Committee.
7. Keep the President and Executive Director fully informed of all developments concerning work of the committee.
8. Other duties and responsibilities as may be delegated by the Association or the Executive Committee.
